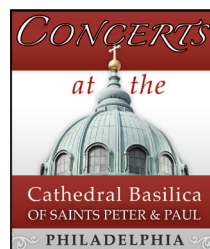
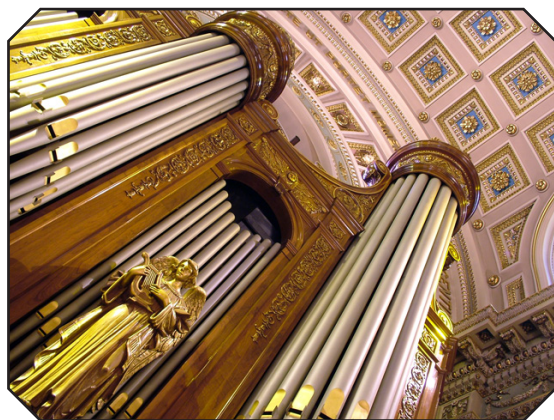
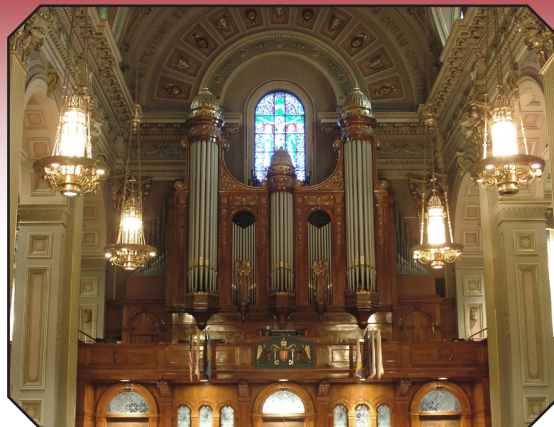
Come join us for spectacular concerts featuring the world's finest musicians in one of the grandest and most historic Cathedral settings in the country.

The Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul is the principal church of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Open in 1864 and located at the East side of Logan Square on 18th Street and the Benjamin Franklin Parkway, it is the largest brownstone structure in Philadelphia and the largest Catholic Church in Pennsylvania.

The Cathedral Basilica measures more than 250 feet in length, 136 feet in width, and approximately 156 feet in height from the floor to the top of the dome. The total height is 209 feet from the floor to the top of the 11-foot gold cross atop the dome, bringing the total height of the Cathedral to 314 feet above the pavement. The dome is an iconic symbol of the Catholic Church in Philadelphia. The great dome is a recognizable sign of this religious landmark among the many civic ones on the Benjamin Franklin Parkway.

Ticket prices for concerts start as low as \$10, and will vary by the artist.

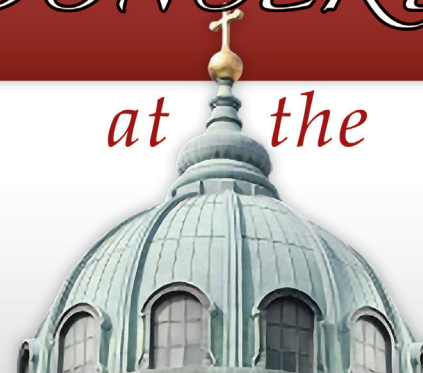
